Area of Work of Organization:

Emergence/Genesis: -

The concept of formation of organization was started by Ms Mousmi Baxla with other six members from tribal community in the year 1989; Ms Baxla is one of the few personalities who dedicated his entire life for the betterment of vulnerable section such as Tribal and Schedule caste, children and women . Soon after completion of graduation she associated with renowned voluntary organization of Hazaribagh, Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra (NBJK) as Social worker since 1985. She saw very closely to the deprived segment during service period in NBJK. Gradually his increasing knowledge and experience in the field compels him to work a lot for the betterment these deprived segments independently. Under this connection he met with various social reformers and intellectuals. As per their consent he organized them on a platform in the name of Lok Prerna Kendra in 1989. Formally, it is registered under Society Registration Act of 21, 1860 in the year 1990 and FCRA in the year 2004. .

Governance:-

The organization is governed by 7 social workers and intellectuals. Out of 7members , 6 are female and remaining 1 is male. It is an organization headed by women. Board Member sits together on six monthly basis and prepares the action plan and review the progress of the organization. The tenure of the member is at least 3 years in general condition. At the present time Mrs. Mausmi Baxla is the Secretary the organization.
